## 1. Governing Policy

# 2. Application

This Procedure applies to all O'Brien Icehouse team members, including employees, contractors, volunteers and work experience staff. All team members are required to comply with and are responsible for knowing and understanding the Procedure.

#### Purpose

It is the purpose of this procedure to detail the process for reporting Child Safety incidents or concerns.

### 4. Reporting

If a person is concerned about an immediate risk to a child's safety, the person must phone Victoria Police on "000" as soon as practicable.
